



RULES OF PARTICIPATION IN THE FESTIVAL

I. TIME

Lodz, 26.06-02.07.2023

Arrival of foreign groups and guests -25.06.2023, departure -03.07.2023

II. PARTICIPATION IN THE FESTIVAL

1. The participants of the festival are:

- a. Children, youth and adults presenting their artistic work individually or as a group on festival stages and during the festival program events.
- b. Children and youth participating in workshops and educational activities.
- c. Youth participating in the festival projects.
- d. Specialists from various fields related to the festival programme.
- e. Young and adult volunteers.
- f. Festival audience.

2. Underage festival participants shall take part in the festival events under supervision of: teachers, trainers, workshop leaders, coordinators of the festival projects or parents.

3. Organized groups and individuals participate in the festival according to the schedule made by the Organiser.

All participants of competitions, concerts, stage presentations or other programme activities are required to be registered at the festival website www.folkoweinspiracje.pl –on-line REGISTRATION by filling in and submitting the **FESTIVAL PARTICIPANT CARD** and are to send it to the address given in the application.

4. Registration takes place **from 01.04.2023**.

5. Registration of a foreign ensemble or delegation should be done by the leader. Individual under age participant should be registered by the leader.

6. Of age participants are registered by themselves.

7. In case of a few groups from one institution, each group has to be registered separately.



8. Volunteers are required to individually fill in the VOLUNTEERING FORM.

9. Admission to the festival events require invitations –available on www.folkoweinspiracje.pl/REJESTRACJA on-line.

10. The registered participant's withdrawal from the festival requires written notification to the following address info@folkoweinspiracje.pl **no later than by 7 days before the beginning of the festival.** If resignation is sent after this date, registration fee will not be reimbursed.

III. REGISTRATION FEE

1. The cost of accommodation and meals is **PLN 120 (25 Euros) per day.**

2. Accreditation for Polish groups taking part in the festival events depends on the number of days.

3. Fees and payments for foreign participants are individually agreed with the leader of delegation and specified in the invitation.

4. The costs of accreditation for a foreign group is **100 Euros** per group and is obligatory.

5. Transport during the festival is guaranteed by the Organiser. Foreign delegations move around by means of their own means of transport which they used in order to get to the festival or it is ensured by the Organiser.

6. The costs of insurance need to be covered by the participants on their own.

7. The transfer must specify the first and family name of the participant or the group name and " FOLK INSPIRATIONS 2023 - participant's/group's name."

8. Foreign participants pay the competition fee and other payments agreed with the Organiser on the day of arrival during checking in at the Festival Office.



IV. PROGRAMME INFORMATION

1. Programme events of the 13th edition of Folk Inspirations are going to take place under the following themes:

FOLK FILM STUDIO

- Preparing film reportage „In the city of folk”
- GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – video competition.

FOLK MUSIC STUDIO

- Recitals of young singers and musicians-instrumentalists as well as music groups presenting characteristic melodies of world cultures and contemporary musical arrangements
- Vocal and music workshops combined with learning a traditional Polish song or a piece of music taken from urban folklore
- Concert of the choir, presenting Polish traditional folk song based on the works of the Polish ethnographer and composer Oskar Kolberg.
- GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – vocal and GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – music competitions.

FOLK DANCE STAGE

- Presentations of traditional and contemporary choreographic groups inspired by folklore on various festival stages, presenting dances of various nations of the world
- Dance Flashmob during concert at Manufaktura.
- Dance theatre performance
- GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – choreography competition
- 3 choreography workshops - Polish, Latin and traditional dances from the participants' country chosen during the festival.
- Folk party for citizens and participants of the festival.
- Short improvised dance activities in the streets

FOLK THEATRE STREET

- Short theatre forms, street theatre performance and other alternative theatre forms
- Festival parade on Piotrkowska street
- Performance prepared by participants gathered around amateur theatre groups with the participation of professional actors
- GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – theatre competition.

FOLK DESIGN FACTORY

- Folk art installation
- Fashion show- presentation of collections inspired by folklore and ethnic culture of different nations
- Folk handicraft workshops
- GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – design competition



FOLK IMAGE ATELIER

- Open-air painting activities
- Open-air photo activities
- GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – drawing and painting, GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – photo competitions,
- Laureates' exhibitions
- Open-air exhibition of photos taken by artists from different countries

FOLK TV STUDIO

- Outdoor studio reporting each day of the festival in a different place.
2. Detailed programme of the festival will be available on www.folkoweinspiracje.pl in **PROGRAMME on 30.04.2023 at the latest.**
 3. **Organiser reserves the right to changes in the programme.**
 4. Festival groups prepare concert programme or street theatre performance with a repertoire related thematically to the idea of the festival:
 - a. choreography groups - from 20 to 45 minutes.,
 - b. vocal and instrumental groups, soloists - from 10 to 20 minutes.
 - c. theatre groups – 1 or 2 presentations up to 30 minutes each
 5. The Organisers will decide on the selection of songs or street performances for festival concerts.
 6. Detailed programme for each group is determined during the festival with the leader.

V. "GOLDEN BOAT 2023" COMPETITIONS

1. **GOLDEN BOAT 2023 Competitions will take place on 27.06.2023-29.06.2023** in the following categories:

GOLDEN BOAT 2023 – VOCAL

3. The virtual form is about preparing artistic presentations, film and photo materials and sending them according to the rules of a given competition.

4. Competition material should be attached to the PARTICIPANT CARD in registration application according to the rules of a given competition.

6. It is necessary to register by means of a registrator on the festival website to take part in the festival-REGISTRATION ON-LINE.

7. The verdict and giving out awards will take place during the concert “Golden Boat 2023”.

8. The submission of diplomas and awards (not collected) will be determined individually with each laureatte by festival office.

VI. SAFETY DURING THE FESTIVAL

1. Safety in the festival venues is guaranteed by the Organiser according to the relevant regulations in force for each of the festival venues.
2. Groups of participants should be accompanied by the minimum number of leaders specified by the relevant regulations in force. The instructor cannot be the sole group leader and cannot be the member of the group. The leaders have the overall responsibility for the presentations and safety of participants as well as an order in the dressing rooms.
3. The Organiser is not responsible for any belongings left behind in dressing rooms and rehearsal halls.
4. The organiser provides medical care to participants on site of the festival events.
5. Participants of the festival are required to have valid travel and health insurance for the whole duration of the festival or the valid insurance from school or a delegating organisation.
